This very productive discussion with TNC chief scientist, Peter Kareiva, opened up a chance to consider possible strengths in a new collaboration with the Nature Conservancy. Kareiva explained that he looks to universities like Cornell to provide a source of innovation in boot-on-the-ground programs that TNC runs. He also emphasized that some TNC programs are capable of tackling problems on a very large scale. He especially considers Cornell to be a leader in areas of renewable energy, economics and sustainable agriculture. After some animated discussion with the group, it was decided that Sustainable Agriculture is a tractable starting point for a future Cornell-TNC partnership. Kareiva suggested the next step is for a visit to campus from TNC's David Cleary to explore what form a partnership could take.
